OUR PROGRAMME MODEL

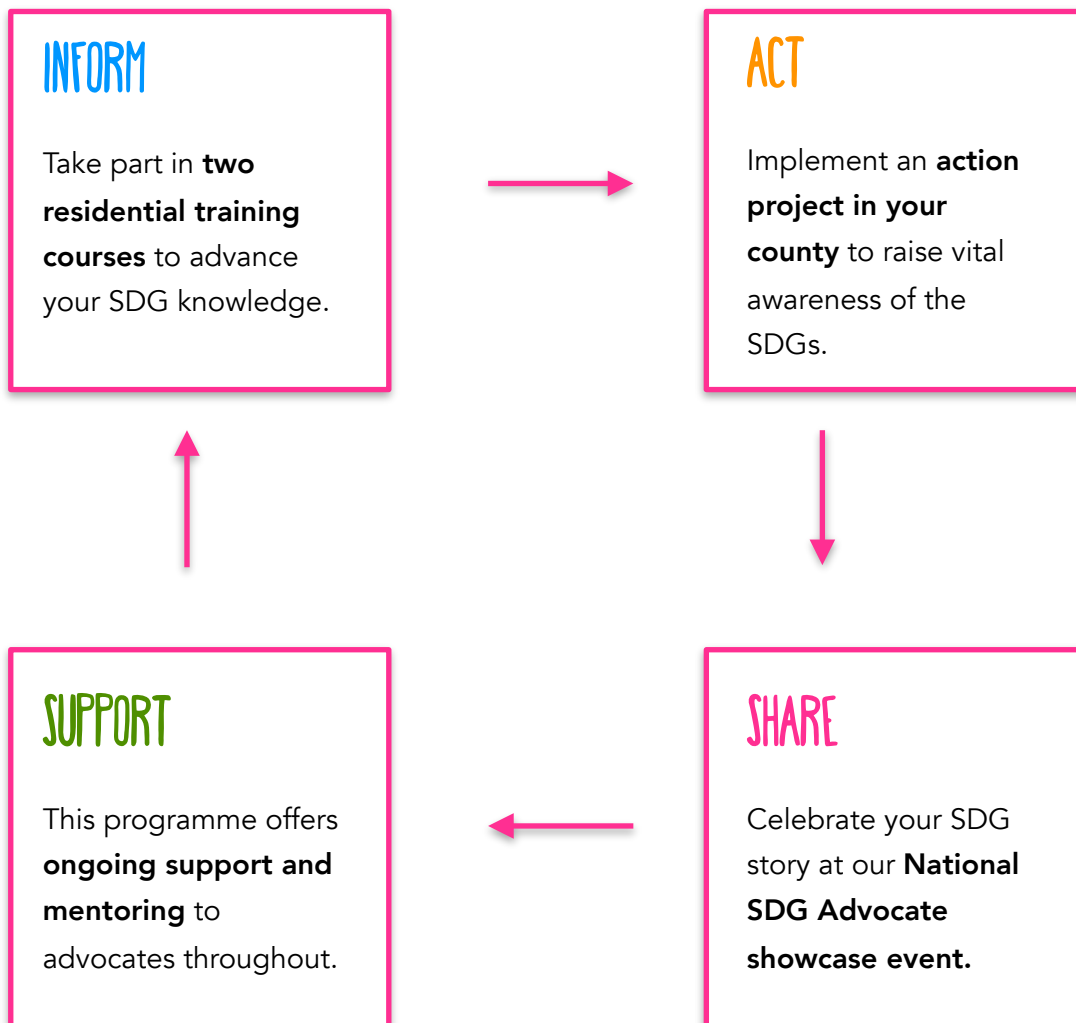
Our educational program is action – driven and promotes experiential learning by supporting the advocates own initiatives and projects.
